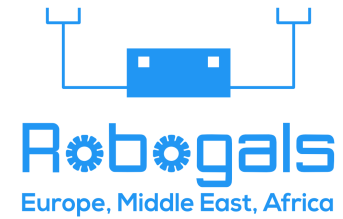


# Regional Mentor Robogals Europe, Middle East & Africa (EMEA)

## The Role

We are currently seeking a motivated individual to take on the position of Regional Mentor, Robogals EMEA.

The Regional Mentors support current EMEA chapters in achieving their goals, assist with the planning and organisation of EMEA SINE, and function as the link between chapters and the Regional Team.

The successful candidate will be an individual passionate about the Robogals mission who shares the organisation's values (see [www.robogals.org/about/about-us/](http://www.robogals.org/about/about-us/)), and has the ability to take initiative, communicate in a professional and engaging manner with a variety of people, and manage projects to support chapters. Chapter experience is preferred. Please note this is a voluntary role.

## Responsibilities

The Regional Mentor reports to the EMEA Regional Executive Officer (REO) and is responsible for:

- Mentoring chapter presidents and chapter executives to achieve their goals via scheduled monthly meetings (or more often as needed).
- Representing chapter interests at the regional level.
- Working with the EMEA Regional Team to develop new initiatives to further assist chapters.
- Assisting in the organisation of the annual Robogals SINE conference.

Although a voluntary position, the successful candidate will have opportunities to gain project management and mentoring experience in an international organisation, develop soft skills, and the opportunity to attend the Robogals SINE annual conference.

## Skills Required

The successful candidate should possess:

- Ability to communicate clearly to a range of people through a variety of media.

- Strategic thinking, forward planning, and initiative in supporting and advising chapters.
- Strong understanding and passion for Robogals' mission, and ability to mentor others to do the same.
- Strong time management skills.
- Past experience as a chapter executive, especially in the President role, is highly valued but not required.

Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until the position is filled. Applicants will be invited for an interview after the application has been received.
